**BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**February 20, 2018**

Chairman King called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance include the following: Commissioners Connelly and Harmon; Deputy County Clerk, April Brunski and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

Consent items: **1. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve the minutes from the February 7, 2018, meeting with one change, **Consent item #9 should read: Commissioner Harmon moved to sign the letter to U.S. Representative Liz Cheney, Senator Mike Enzi and Senator John Barrasso in support of Wilderness Study Release Language in areas in Lincoln County.** Motion carried. **2. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the Resolution for the 2017-2018 Budget Amendment to create a Capital Outlay line item in the amount of \$163,975 with funds being transferred from Unreserved Fund Balance. Motion carried. **3. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the vouchers. Motion carried. **4. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve File #803 AP 18 Snake River Junction Third Filing with Findings of Approval A thru C. Motion carried. **5. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve File #801 AP 18 Vacation of Blue Grouse Roost Subdivision Plat with a Resolution of Approval. Motion carried. **6. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the letter to Greg Brown in support of the Crow Creek Pipeline Project. Motion carried. **7. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the letter to Cindy Crane, President & CEO of Rocky Mountain Power to respectfully request that PacifiCorp/Rocky Mountain Power pursue an extension of the U.S. EPA Air Quality conditions for Naughton Power Plant Unit 3. Motion carried. **8. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the letter to Bridger-Teton National Forest on Noxious Weed EIS Scoping within Bridger-Teton National Forest in Lincoln County. Motion carried.

The money to increase the line item will be taken from the Unreserved Fund balance. No public comments were received. **2.
