

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
May 22, 2018

Chairman King called the meeting to order at 9:49 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Connelly and Harmon; Deputy County Clerk, April Brunski; County Attorney, Spencer Allred and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

Consent items: **1. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve the consent items. Motion was adopted. **2. Commissioner Harmon** moved to reject all bids for the 2018 Hams Fork County Road Dust Suppression Project due to non-responsive bidders. Motion was adopted. **3. Commissioner Harmon** moved for the Chairman to sign the letter to the Wyoming Department of Transportation for the Final Reconnaissance Report for the Ham's Fork River Bridge Replacement – County Road 327 (Fox Farm Road) memorandum. Motion was adopted. **4. Commissioner Connelly** moved to award the engineering contract for work at the Thayne solid waste facility to WENCK Engineering and authorize the Chairman to sign the contract after it has been approved by the County Attorney. Motion was adopted. **5. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the special rate contracts for Brooks, Town of Diamondville, City of Kemmerer, Miller Sanitation, Reliable Refuse Disposal, Star Valley Disposal, Star Valley Meat Block, Valley Sanitation and WestBank Sanitation. Motion was adopted with **Commissioner Harmon** opposed. **6. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the Resolution of the Termination of the North Afton Water and Sewer District. Motion was adopted. **7. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the resolution of Dissolution of the Star Valley View Improvement and Service District. Motion was adopted. **6. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the vouchers. Motion was adopted.

Discussion items: **1. County Engineer, Amy Butler** gave an agency update on the following: bids for CMAQ 2018 Hams Fork County Road Dust Suppression Project, 2018 County Road Pavement Markings, Commissioners would like to move forward with applying for an HRRRP Grant to pay for most of the pavement markings on LaBarge Creek Road next year; county road speed studies. **2. Solid Waste Director, Mary Crosby** discussed the following: selecting an engineering firm for the work in Thayne; special rate contracts for 2018-2019 - Commissioner King would like to have something in place by July 1st to aid citizens in financial need; setting Star Valley clean-up date for June 9th, flat fee of \$10 per load but does not include tires, limited to 1 refrigerator per load; obtaining further information from the Idaho landfill group. **3. Commissioner King** discussed Sterling Urgent Care. He has talked with their representative and wants to look further into it as it would be a great benefit for the employees. The Commissioners agreed to move forward with meeting with Sterling as soon as possible. **4. South Lincoln Medical Center CEO, Karl Sundberg** discussed the importance of keeping residents and surrounding residents in Kemmerer for their medical care as the hospital is subsidized through their tax dollars; said their urgent care will be open by the end of the year, most likely by early fall and he is open to discussing a subscription service for the urgent care with the Commissioners. **County Sheriff, Shane Johnson** discussed the following: \$1200 savings in medical costs for an inmate by calling around and pre-registering for a service an hour drive away; intercom replacement in the amount of \$31,000; upgrading to a full size transport van **5. Representatives** with Sterling Urgent Care in Afton stopped in to see if there were any questions. Commissioner King let them know that they are setting up a meeting

with Sami Evans to discuss getting it set up for the employees. **6. Road & Bridge Supervisor, Matt McCloud** gave the appraisal to the Commissioners for the land and building by the Landfill. Commissioners told him to move forward with listing the property for sale.
