

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
BUDGET HEARING
July 15, 2013

Chairman Jenkins called the hearing to order at 5:00 p.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Connelly and Wolfley; County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner; County Attorney, Josh Smith and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

PARA 1: Commissioner Connelly moved to approve the agenda for the evening and Commissioner Wolfley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PARA 2: Chairman Jenkins opened the Public Hearing for the Budget Hearing at 5:01 p.m.

Public comments:

Clerk of District Court, Ken Roberts asked if there would be any raises for any county employees. Chairman Jenkins said no.

Solid Waste Director, Mary Crosby stated that she had an employee that would have an adjustment due to a job reclassification. Commissioner Connelly said that there were also some step increases in a department.

Commissioner Wolfley said he appreciated those that submitted and worked on budgets. There was a lot of cooperation from departments and suggestions given during the budget process.

Chairman Jenkins thanked the county employees for the work they do.

Commissioner Connelly said we are surrounded by counties with much more money. Services and everything we do will be scrutinized in future budgets.

County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner asked the Commissioners to return the \$3100 the Commissioners removed from her salary budget. This was money that was given last year during raises and was not used.

Ken Roberts asked what the county reserves look like. Commissioner Connelly said after the money is allocated to the Justice Center, he projects 4-5 million in reserves when finished.

Chairman Jenkins closed the hearing at 5:11 p.m.

Commissioner Wolfley moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:11 p.m. and Commissioner Connelly seconded the motion. Motion carried.
