## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Board of Commissioners of the County of Lincoln is seeking public input and public comments on a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application. Lincoln County is interested in obtaining funding for the demolition of the empty, former law enforcement facility located on the Courthouse block which has been designated as “spot slum and blight” by the county and improvements necessary for ADA compliance in the public restrooms. The grant request contemplated will not exceed \$500,000.

Other possible CDBG applications may be considered provided they support at least one of three National Objectives:

1. Benefit to low and moderate income persons
2. Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight
3. Activities designed to meet community development needs having a particular urgency.
