

**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**  
**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**April 19, 2016**

Commissioner Harmon called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Connelly and King; Deputy County Clerk, April Brunski; and County Attorney, Spencer Allred. County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner and Commissioner’s Secretary, Corey Roberts were in attendance in the afternoon session.

**Consent Items:** 1. **Commissioner King** moved to approve the consent items for the day. Motion was adopted. 2. **Commissioner King** moved to approve the Grant application with the State of WY, Department of Family Services for TANF/CPI. Motion was adopted. 3. **Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the Subcontract between FiberTel Inc. and Drillrite in the amount of \$219,150 for bores and handhole installation. Motion adopted. 4. **Commissioner King** moved to sign the Subcontract between FiberTel and M&T Underground in the amount of \$219,150 for bores and handhole installation. Motion adopted. 5. **Commissioner King** moved to sign the Modification of Grant or Agreement for bark beetle mitigation. Motion adopted. 6. **Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the vouchers for the day. Motion adopted. 7. **Commissioner Connelly** moved for the Chairman to sign the agreement between WYDOT and the Board of County Commissioners for the chip seal project on Shute Creek and Elkol Roads in the amount of \$513,010. Motion adopted. 8. **Commissioner Connelly** moved to allow the City of Kemmerer to dump free at the landfill during their clean-up week. Motion adopted. 9. **Commissioner Connelly** moved to waive the Landfill fee for the Town of Opal for their clean-up week. Motion adopted.
