

**OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**  
**BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**August 23, 2016**

Chairman Harmon called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Connelly and King; County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner; County Attorney, Spencer Allred and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

**Consent Items:** **1. Commissioner King** moved to approve the consent items. Motion was adopted. **2. Commissioner King** moved to ratify the amended resolution establishing fire closure for Lincoln County. Motion was adopted. **3. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the MOU with the Town of Thayne providing for the Thayne North Waterline replacement project to go across county property. Motion was adopted. **4. Commissioner King** moved to sign the resolution on the County Wide Consensus Block grant with the Town of Diamondville Conroy Bridge project to be reallocated to street projects in the amount of \$30,728. Motion was adopted. **5. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the vouchers. Motion was adopted. **6. Commissioner Connelly** moved to go into Executive Session at 11:02 a.m. with the County Attorney for legal matters. Motion was adopted. **Commissioner Connelly** moved to return to Regular Session at 11:33 a.m. Motion was adopted. **7. Commissioner Connelly** moved to table file 404 SS 16, simple subdivision until the September 7<sup>th</sup> commission meeting. Motion was adopted. **8. Commissioner King** moved to table 301 PZ 16 until the September 7<sup>th</sup> meeting. Motion was adopted. **9. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve 805 AP 16 - Alpine Village Plat 3 Amended 9<sup>th</sup>, WJW Holdings, Inc. with findings of approval A-C. Motion was adopted. **10. Commissioner King** moved to approve the 3 year agreement with Allwest for the 50 mb ETS VLAN Circuit between the Courthouse and Afton Branch Office for \$1369 per month, pending the County Attorney's review and using Silverstar in the interim. Motion was adopted. **11. Commissioner King** moved to sign the resolution for the Kemmerer/Diamondville JPB applying for a Mineral Royalties Grant through the Wyoming State Lands and Investments Board in the amount of \$280,946. Motion was adopted. **12. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the agreement with the Kemmerer Senior Citizen's Center for the administration of the Community Development Block grant for a new center.

**Discussion Items:** **1. Kemmerer Gazette** publication bill. **2. 24 Malt Beverage** permit for the Star Valley Rotary Club. **3. Petition for formation** of the Broken Wheel Ranch Improvement and Service District. The public hearing will be held on October 18, 2016 at 10:15 a.m. **4. Damage to a vehicle** from a falling tree limb. The vehicle was parked on the street by the courthouse. **5. Development Specialist, Jeanette Fagnant** discussed 404 SS 16 – second Amended Jensen's Corner – James M. Jensen & Ann Jensen Family Trust and request it be tabled to the September 7, 2016 meeting. **6. Planning Director, John Woodward** discussed 301 PZ 16 – variance relief of setback – Clint Frome, applicant. Clint Frome addressed the Commissioners on what happened with the shed he built and apologized for not getting a building permit. Kate Walters addressed issues with the fence on their property being damaged yearly and wants this rectified. She stated the shed has been a problem from day one. **7. Jeanette discussed 805 AP 16** – Alpine Village Plat 3 Amended 9<sup>th</sup> filing, WJW Holdings, Inc. amended plat. **8. County Engineer, Amy Butler** gave an agency update on the following: Elkol road project, CMAQ grant, TAP

grant review, HRRR grant applications, and the new Road and Bridge shop. **9. GIS/IT Director, Destry Dearden** met with the Commissioners on the following: 50 Mb Kemmerer-Afton connection, Fair IT support, Wi-Fi security, parcel adjustments in the Narrows to Turnerville area, GIS updates and enhancements causing a certificate error. **10. Gary Hutchinson, Director of the Kemmerer/Diamondville JPB** met with the Commissioners on a Mineral Royalties grant application resolution and the Oakley Improvement and Service district joining the JPB. **11. Maintenance Supervisor, Matt Mochel** met with the Commissioners on sewer line problems at the Courthouse. **12. Bob Peternal with the Kemmerer Senior Center Board** met with the Commissioners on the feasibility study and the location of the new center. **13. The Commissioners** met with Public Health Nurse Manager, Patrice Baker on health services for La Barge. Patrice said that services are available from Sublette County using the Big Piney Clinic, which would be closer for residents to drive to that facility. Patrice said they would still go to the Senior Center in La Barge to do the flu clinic. **14. Travis Osmond, Weed and Pest Supervisor** and Board Members met with the Commissioners and gave an agency update on the following: online data base for hay producers, dyers woad program, war on weeds day, Alpine spray day, 2016 Back Pack Crew, youth groups involved in service projects and areas sprayed in the county. Bill Sears and George Collins voiced their concerns with the helicopter spraying and lack of being contacted in a timely manner. Travis suggested the formation of a Hams Fork Cooperative Weed Management Area which is a legal plan submitted to the State of Wyoming. Jayson Fox suggested utilizing a map to chart out who's spraying and who isn't and getting a plan together. Don Lamborn had questions on the money allocation if a group is formed.
