BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
February 16, 2016

Chairman Harmon called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Connelly and King; County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner; County Attorney, Josh Smith and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

**Consent Items:** **1. Commissioner King** moved to approve the consent items. Motion was adopted. **2. Commissioner King** moved to approve the vouchers. Motion was adopted. **3. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve amending the application to purchase State Trust land adjacent to the Thayne Waste Facility and authorizing the Chairman to sign all paperwork necessary to amend the application. Motion was adopted. **4. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign letter to the Bridger Teton Forest Service on the Grey's River motor vehicle closure and the Commissioner's opposition to it. Motion was adopted. **5. Commissioner King** moved to sign the letter to the U.S. Forest Service on the Hams Fork timber and restoration funding request. Motion was adopted. **6. Commissioner King** moved to sign the agreement with WYDOT on job number 572-7638 for Highway 233, Highway 189 and Highway 30/189 pending County Attorney review. Motion was adopted. **7. Commissioner Connelly** moved to sign the amended documents on the UPRR crossing agreements for the fiber optic project pending County Attorney review. Motion was adopted. **8. Commissioner King** moved to sign the corrected version on the contract specifications for the Outside Plant Additions to the Sage Junction to Kemmerer Exchange (fiber optic project). Motion was adopted.

**Discussion Items:** **1.** 24 Hour Malt Beverage permit request for the Star Valley Jaycees and the Grover Hill Climbs – permit was approved for February 26-27<sup>th</sup>. **2. Extension Office County Coordinator, Shar Perry** gave an agency update. **3. 4-H Youth Educator, Miriam Feeley** met with the Commissioners on a letter to Exxon about the Kemmerer Arena improvements funding. **4. Phillip Cameron, Executive Director of Energy Conservation Works** gave an update on the energy improvement program that they operate with Lower Valley Energy. Over \$80,000 has been loaned to north Lincoln County residents to make their homes energy efficient. **5. Solid Waste Director, Mary Crosby** met with the Commissioners on State land by the Thayne landfill. **6. Senior Planner, Jonathan Teichert** met with the Commissioners on correspondence and the fiber optic project. **7. Mayor Neuenschwander** with the Town of Afton, **Town of Afton Administrator, Hyun Kim,** and **Utility Director, Larry Lancaster** met with the Commissioners on a location for a sewer lagoon and septic dumping in the north end of the town.
