BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
February 21, 2017

Chairman King called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioner Connelly; County Clerk, Jeanne Wagner and Commissioner’s Secretary, Corey Roberts. Commissioner Harmon was absent from the meeting.

Consent Items: **1. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the consent agenda. Motion was adopted. **2. Commissioner Connelly** moved for the Chairman to sign the contract with Star Valley Glass in the amount of \$4700 for the Attorney’s office doors in Afton and with Hams Fork Construction in the amount of \$7055 for the Attorney’s office in Kemmerer. Motion was adopted. **3. Commissioner Connelly** moved to appoint Nancy Stafford to fill the unexpired term of Kathy Hess on the Fair Board with the term to expire December 31, 2020; and to appoint Wendy Kirk to fill the unexpired term of Patty Taylor with the term to expire on December 31, 2020. Motion was adopted. **4. Commissioner Connelly** moved for the Chairman to sign easement application for the property above the Swab Creek Road. Motion was adopted. **5. Commissioner Connelly** moved to approve the vouchers for the day. Motion was adopted.

Public Health Nurse Manager, Patrice Baker** gave an agency update on the following: new Public Health Nurse Response Coordinator, and vaccine budget going in to arrears. **3.
