

Save PDFs from iDocMarket (Tips from Tyler Technologies)

Google Chrome

In the print dialogue, choose “Save as PDF” as your printer. You will then be prompted for the location of where to save the document. Click save once you have named it and set a location.

Internet Explorer

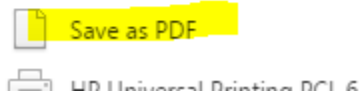
You will need to download [CutePDF](#), a free PDF generator. Once this is installed, choose the CutePDF option on the print dialogue. You will then be prompted for a location to save the pdf.

Help with Printing Plats Scanned in Landscape using Google Chrome

Select a destination

Make sure “Save as PDF” is selected as the printer. If not, choose it from the “Change...” button.

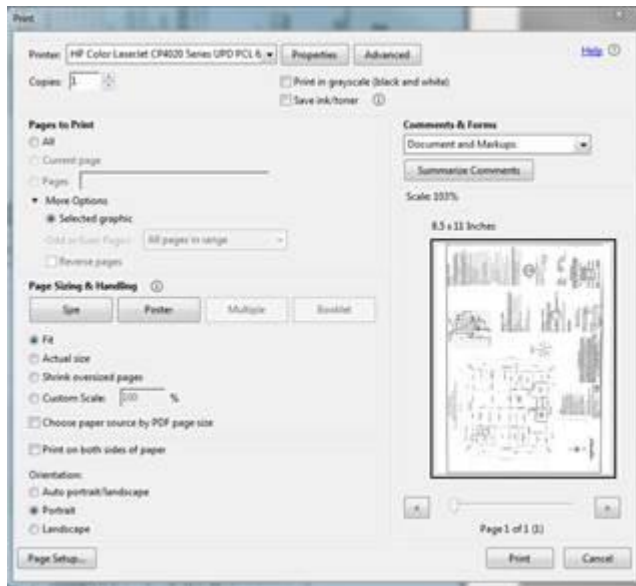
Save the PDF to your desktop or whatever folder you desire.

Open the PDF in Adobe Reader and choose View – Rotate View – Clockwise.

Next, choose Tools – Select & Zoom – Snapshot Tool

Then, draw a rectangle around the image you’d like to print.

Next, choose File – Print and you’ll see the following screen:



Make sure the highlighted sections are selected and that the printer you're printing to is setup to the correct paper size.

Alternatively, if the computer has a PDF printer on it, you could print to the PDF printer with this now trimmed down PDF.
