

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS  
BOARD OF LINCOLN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
July 16, 2019

Chairman Connelly called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Others in attendance included the following: Commissioners Harmon and King; County Clerk, April Brunski; County Attorney, Spencer Allred (via video conference) and Commissioner's Secretary, Corey Roberts.

**Consent items:** **1. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve the consent agenda, minutes from July 2-3, 2019, orders for reduction/addition to the assessment roll and approval of the vouchers. **2. Commissioner King** moved to approve the FY 2019-2020 County Budget. **3. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the Appropriation Resolution and Resolution to Provide Income Necessary to Finance Budget for 2019-2020 for 12 mills. Motion was adopted. **4. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve the following Irrigation Districts: Porto, Dry Creek, East Side, Smith's Fork, Etna and, contingent on completing their hearing and filing the documents with the Commissioners, Cottonwood. Motion was adopted. **5. Commissioner King** moved to approve the Special District mill levies and Special Assessments for fiscal year 2019-2020. **6. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign a Resolution Authorizing the Submission of an Application for Federal Funding through the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality administered by the Wyoming Department of Transportation for Lincoln County, Wyoming, for the Purpose of the 2020 CMAQ Dust Suppression Project. Motion was adopted. **7. Commissioner King** moved to sign the following for CMAQ funding for fiscal year 2020: Application, Right of Way & Utility Certificate, Lobbying Certificate and Identification of Title IV/EEO Coordinator. Motion was adopted. **8. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the Final Acceptance for the 2017 Hwy 233 Multi- Use Trail Project. Motion was adopted. **9. Commissioner Harmon** moved to appoint Robert E. King to be the viewer representing the Board of County Commissioners for the IRP-Strawberry Creek re-alignment. Motion was adopted. **10. Commissioner King** moved to sign the Cooperative Agreement between Lincoln County and Trout Unlimited to access the County property for staging purposes for the Swift Creek Restoration and Stabilization Project. Motion was adopted. **11. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the Surface Owner Consent for Exploratory Drilling along County Road 306 Sublet-Pomeroy Basin. Motion was adopted. **12. Commissioner Harmon** moved to approve giving \$2,000 to the LaBarge Senior Center to assist with an awning. Motion was adopted. **13. Commissioner Harmon** moved to sign the Resolution Designating April Brunski, Lincoln County Clerk, the Public Records Person for Lincoln County. Motion was adopted. **14. Commissioner King** moved to sign the amended contract between the Wyoming Department of Public Health and Lincoln County. Motion was adopted.

**Discussion items:** **1. Chairman Connelly** welcomed Charity Lafontaine from Congresswoman Cheney's Office who stated that she was in Town to meet the new City of Kemmerer Administrator as well as listen to the broadband presentation this afternoon by Russ Elliott with the Wyoming Business Council. **2. Commissioner Harmon** commented that the budget was just approved at 12 mills, we are going into uncharted territory and joins with his other two Commissioners who he appreciates very much. He wants to show solidarity as we move into this territory and, with that being said, agrees with the budget. **3. Chairman Connelly** echoed upon Commissioner Harmon's comments and stated that we are going into uncertain times in Lincoln County with the unknown of where Rocky Mountain Power is heading. He added that problems could've been worse if Westmoreland hadn't stepped up to the plate to make the agreement with the taxes owed and commented, for the record, that Rob Piippo with Westmoreland should be thanked by the people of the community for what was done in stepping up

and paying the back taxes because they did not have to make that decision as they did. **3. Amy Butler, County Engineer**, discussed CMAQ Application FY2020 – applies magnesium chloride to 55 miles of County Roads and 9.5 miles of Dempsey Road ;TAP-2017 Hwy 233 multi-use trail project; IRP-Strawberry Creek re-alignment; Swift Creek Stream Restoration and Stabilization Project staging area and AML Project – exploratory drilling **4. County Treasurer, Jerry Greenfield**, presented the financial report for June and reported that the first Westmoreland payment has been made per the agreement. **5. County Sheriff, Shane Johnson**, commented that the County reserves are growing every year and pointed out that there are some good things and positive things going on in the County despite the concerns that are coming up. **6. Kathy Tomassi, Wyoming Business Council**, introduced videographer, **Andy Greenman**, who is in town to take video around Kemmerer for the Wyoming Business Council. **7. Russ Elliott, Wyoming Business Council Broadband Manager**, gave a presentation on broadband and the possibilities for Lincoln County. He contends that he can help tremendously, requested an inventory of the area and will send survey cards to the County to be distributed to residents. **8. Patrice Baker, Public Health Nurse Manager**, presented the contract for the County State Officer and gave an agency update.
